To sweeten the winter, we are organising a transnational meeting as part of the re.sources project for you and us.

We already have the first information for you: If you are interested, please register now, or at the latest by the end of February. At the beginning of March you will get all the details about accommodation etc. You are welcome to invite family and friends. The minimum age is 18 years, but there is no upper age limit. Like the whole project, the transnational meeting is funded by Erasmus+. So there are no costs for you if you take part.

The **meeting** will take place from **Friday, 25 March to Sunday, 27 March 2022 in the Chartreuse** (France), in St. Pierre d'Entremont / Savoie.

What is it about? The [re.sources](#) project has been running since spring 2020 and invites young adults from all over the Alpine region to tackle the issue of living in a resource-friendly way.

Many projects have already been developed, the opportunities of job shadowing have been taken and in 2021 we met in Biella to discuss ecosystem services.

What can you expect from the transnational meeting 2022?

Friday: Arrival (If you're travelling by public transport, it's best to arrive in Chambéry by lunchtime as there's a bus from there to St Pierre d'Entremont / Savoie at 12.30pm). After the check-in, we will directly explore conflicts of use and possible solutions during an excursion into the forest.

Saturday: Luigi from the Association Canopee takes up the topic of conflicts of use. Under his supervision, we will immerse into a controversy on conflicts about soil and ground, in order to explore its complexity through action. Our all aim is to defend what we stand for. But what (is), if we reframe societal issues, outside of the binary choices "for" or "against"? How can we recompose the landscape of contradictory interests, once we take into account the constraints that weigh on each actor? What type of action is then possible?

Sunday: We reflect on our experiences within the re.sources project. Who implemented which projects? What did we learn during the job shadowings? What are our take-aways? And where do we go from here? Around noon, we will start our journey home.
